Sanctum Care Group: (306) 244-1200 & select option below:

- HART - HIV/AIDS Response Team - Supports clients staying in hospital to complete medical treatment.
- CORT – Community Outreach Team - Engages & links clients (CD4 count < 200) into HIV care .
- PORT - Prenatal Outreach Team - provides wrap around support for pregnant women (LWHIV).
- Sanctum - Hospice with respite & supportive care for people living with / and affected HIV.
- Sanctum 1.5 – Transitional care home that provides care for pregnant women LWHIV or high –risk. Moms admitted prior to delivery. Provide Moms with support + care for their babies.
